## BIKE FOR BREAD 2006 WATERFORD, CT

Longer Ride for ages 14+

Left out of WHS, Left onto Great Neck Rd., Right onto Lamphere Rd., Left onto Shore Rd., Right onto Jordan Cove Rd., Loop around Millstone area (Windward Way), Right out of Jordan Cove area onto Shore Rd. to New Shore Rd. back to Shore Rd., Right onto Rte. 213 (Great Neck), Stay right on 213, right onto Ridgewood Ave., Left onto Highland Ave. (past Ocean Beach)

Left onto Park St. around the point to Pequot Ave., Left onto Gardner Ave., Right onto Ocean Ave., Left onto 213 (Niles Hill Rd.) Left onto Dimmock Rd., Straight/right onto Great Neck Rd., Stay on Great Neck to 156, Right on Rte. 156 back to the high school.
